of summer.

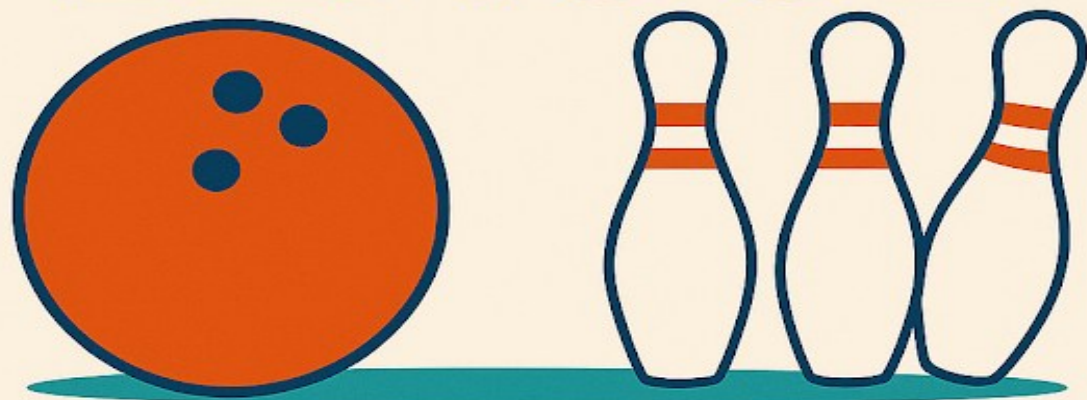
And they can dance
